(4) The Qualifications of a Leader

ITim:3:2 Now the overseer must be above reproach, the husband of but one wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. NIV

The heart of the issue...ITim.3:2

What is the first and perhaps most basic requirement for an Elder? vs.2a Job 1:1; 8

The Elder *must* be above reproach. Literally, "unable to be held" with true charges.

And what is the first way 'above reproach' looks like? vs.2

Must be a 'one-woman man'. Seems to address the rampant polygamy in Ephesus.

What does this passage not say? Heb.13:4; ICor.7:8, 15; Mt.19:9

Not prohibiting married, unmarried, widowed, divorced. Upholds the Godly standard.

What's the second way to be above reproach? vs.2 3:2, 11; Titus 2:2 See Eph.5:18

The Elder must be temperate (wine-less), sober minded. Primarily re clear thinking.

What's the third way to be above reproach? vs.2

To be prudent (reign in, controlled) in mind. Not given to rash decisions. Thoughtful.

What's the fourth way to be above reproach? vs.2 ITim.2:9, modest

To be respectable (orderly, modest). This is a man who has an orderly life, not chaotic.

And the fifth way? vs.2

He is to be hospitable, fond of guests. An example of Christian service.

What's now connected to the *function* of the Elder? vs.2b IITim.2:15, 24-26 Titus 1:9

He is to be *able* to teach (the Scriptures). Able to correct. Rightly dividing the Word.

The four 'nots' of the Elder...ITim.3:3

What are the (4) things Elders are not to be noted for? vs.3

1) Not a drinker 2) not violent, but gentle 3) not quarrelsome 4) not a lover of money.

What's the emphasis of #1, not a drinker?

He is not known as a drinker, even if it doesn't result in drunkenness. Above reproach.

What about #2? How is this described?

Never reacts with physical violence. Known as a gentle person.

And #3?

Not contentious. Not a person with a short fuse, one who needs to be avoided.

What's the heart of #4? IPet.5:2; ITim.6:10

This is more about what he wants than what he has. Ministry is not for financial gain.
