(13) The Righteous shall live by faith

## The exploitation of freedom in Christ...5:13-15

What is Paul's summary statement to believers? vs.13a 1:6; 5:8

You, brothers, were called (the call of salvation) to be free (of living under Law).

However, what is his warning and then command to the believer? vs.13b IPet.2:16; Rom.13:14

Don't claim freedom to indulge sin! Not Lawless! Rather, love one another.

Is it possible for a true believer to abuse their freedom in Christ? vs.13 Comment?

Obviously, yes, because of this warning. It's the usual 'justification' from the Judaizers!

Was this problem (license) a surprise to God? Jude 3-4 Comment?

Absolutely not! They distort Grace/freedom into license/sin. "In among you", in Church.

What elegant summary of the Law does Paul quote? vs.14; Mt.7:12; 22:34-40; Rom.13:8-10

Love your neighbor as yourself, IS the intent of the moral Law. This is from the heart.

What is true about the believer in Christ that makes this possible? Rom.5:5; Eph.1:13-14

It's *only* possible by yielding to the indwelling Holy Spirit. Only He can love God's love.

From Paul's letter thus far, what was obviously happening in these churches? vs.15 Why?

There was internal bickering. The Judaizers against the anti-nomians. Laws/license...

Does Satan really care which one of these lies dominates? Why?? Jn.8:44

Not really. He's a liar and the father of lies. As long as the truth is obscured.

## Living life by faith...5:16-18

What is God's plan for how a believer is to live life? vs.16a see <u>IICor.3</u>

We are to *live by the (Holy) Spirit*. This is contrasted to living by the sinful nature (flesh).

By review, what are the two extremes of living by the sinful nature (flesh)? 5:4; 5:13

Living by laws / regulations or living with total disregard for sin. Both are condemned.

IF we **DO** walk (live life) by the Spirit, what will we **NOT DO**? vs.16

We will NOT gratify the desires of the sinful nature (flesh). This is simply not possible!

Why is this (not possible)? vs.17a

What the Spirit wants and what the flesh wants are absolute opposites! No commonality.

What is the result of this internal struggle for the believer? vs.17b Rom.7:14-25

The flesh tries to keep us from doing what we know, by the Spirit, is right. Warfare!

How does the true believer get out from under the law (deeds of the flesh)? vs.18

By being led by the Holy Spirit. Yielding our will to His will and obeying His directions.
