After The Deluge

*But God remembered Noah ...Gen.8*

After the 150 days, what happens? 8:1-3

**Rains stop, wind dries up the earth, and the subterranean eruptions stop. Water recedes.**

Why the detail about exactly when the ark rested? vs.4 Ex.13:4; 12:2; 12:6

**Because the ark rested the same day/month that Jesus would rise from the grave.**

What happens on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the 10<sup>th</sup> month? vs. 5 Why would that be important to Noah?

**The tops of the (other) mountains become visible. Noah could see progress!**

What is the first “spy” Noah sends into the new world? vs.7 Result?

**He sent out a raven which didn't return, just flying all over but not returning.**

What is the 2<sup>nd</sup> “spy”? vs. 8 And the result? vs.9

**He sent out the dove. Couldn't find a clean resting place and returned to Noah.**

What is possibly signified by the repeated “7 days”? vs.10, 12

**Quite possibly he send the birds out on the Sabbath. Finally, olive branch, time of rest.**

How did the dove return the second time? vs.11 Comment?

**Returned with a fresh picked olive branch. Peace at last. God's judgment was done.**

What does Noah observe on the 27<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month? vs. 16? Result? vs.15-17

**The earth was dry, ready again, so God calls them all out of the ark to multiply...**

*Everything starts over... Gen.8:18-22*

What happens first? vs.18

**Noah first, then his family with him, leave the ark to a totally new world.**

What does vs. 19 seem to imply about dinosaurs, and such?

**Scripture says everything that moves on the earth. They were all there.**

What does Noah immediately initiate? vs.20 What does this show us about Noah?

**He offered a burnt offering to the Lord. Obviously the Lord had taught him to do so.**

Describe the result? vs.21

**The Lord smelled the soothing aroma, and promised Himself, never again, this way.**

What are the (4) couplets God promises will not cease, while the earth remains? vs.22

**Seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night.**

What is clearly taught and implied in this verse about the duration of the earth itself? II Pet.3:1-13

**This present earth will also be destroyed, but by fire next time.**

What is one of the major applications for us today spawned by the days of Noah? II Pet.3:8-11

**The Lord has not forgotten. He's delaying, like with Methuselah, for repentance...**
