Get Mark and bring him with you, because he is helpful to me in my ministry. 12 I sent Tychicus to Ephesus. 13 When you come, bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas, and my scrolls, especially the parchments.

They all deserted him! Alexander persecuted him but his friends just fled! He's alone...

What do we observe about Paul's deeply held attitude here? 4:16b; Lu.23:33-34; Acts 7:54-60

Paul, like Jesus and Stephen (and countless others) forgave his tormentors. True Grace.

But, is he really alone? What does Paul reveal about his trial? 4:17a; Acts 23:11; Ps.37:39-40

The Lord stood at my side and gave me strength! Likely 'deny Christ or...'. He held firm.

Besides strengthening Paul, what was the Lord's purpose here? 4:17; Acts.9:15; Eph.3:8

It was so that through Paul the message (Gospel) might be fully proclaimed; all Gentiles...

What does Paul confidently maintain? 4:17b-18; Prov.28:15; IIPet.2:9; Rom.8:28-39

I was delivered from the lion's mouth, I will be rescued and He will bring me safely Home!

Where have we met Priscilla and Aquila? Acts 18:1-4,18-28; Rom.16:3-5; see ICor.1:11-12

<u>Likely converts by Paul, followed/served Paul even risking their lives. Quietly led Apollos.</u>

What about Onesiphorus? What do we know about him? 4:19; 1:15-18

<u>Paul honored him highly. Served Paul, unashamed of his chains. He prayed mercy on him.</u>

What is significant about Paul's comment regarding Trophimus? 4:20; see Acts 28:7-10

<u>Paul left him at Miletus sick. The 'sign gift' of healing was passing. No longer needed.</u>

Comment on Paul's last words. 4:22 (The Lord be with your spirit. Grace be with you.)

<u>This would be Paul's epitaph. Grace be with you! Salvation by grace alone...Eph.2:8-10</u>
