He knows Jesus as the Lamb of God and the Son of God. First official recognition?!

What's implied re John knowing Jesus when the Sanhedrin had quizzed him? 1:26-27; 29, 31

At that time he didn't know Him. See Mt.3:13-17 for further details of His revealing.

What does John clarify about his knowledge and mission? 1:30-31

I testified (to Sanhedrin, 1:26), He is coming. My mission was/is to reveal Him to Israel.

What was John's confirmation that Jesus is the One? 1:32-34; Mt.3:13-17

At the baptism of Christ, the Holy Spirit, like a dove, descended and remained on Him.

John's inquiry to Jesus...Mt.11:7-15

Despite John's recognition of Jesus, Son of God (1:34), what happens later? Mt.11:2-3 After ~1 year/prison, feels abandoned, confused (King?), seeks confirmation. Like us! What was Jesus' gentle response? 11:4-6; Lu.4:16-19, 7:18-23; Isa.35:4-6, 42:5-7 Tell John what you hear/see! Compare it with Scripture! Let that be your comfort!! And what final encouragement does Jesus give to John? 11:6; Rom.9:32-33; ICor.1:22-23 Blessed is the one who does not stumble over me. John just needed to be encouraged! After John's disciples leave, what does Jesus testify about John? 11:7-9 John was not intimidated, not living luxury. Prophet? Yes/he was more than a prophet. How was John 'more than a prophet'? 11:10; Isa.35:4-6, 42:5-7; Lu.1:15-17 He was privileged to be the forerunner of Christ, the announcer that Messiah was here! What was Jesus proclaiming in 11:11? See Jn.3:5-6 John was greatest of human birth. But those spiritually born, even least, are greater! What was continuing during John's ministry? 11:12-13 Comment? Eph.6:11-13 All prophets and the Law suffer violence and violent men. Jesus, *The Prophet* will also. And to him who has ears to hear (11:15), who is John the Baptist? 11:14; Mal.4; Lu.1:17 For those who are willing to hear/accept it, John is Elijah who was to come. Per Mal.4.
