

The Revelation

(20) The Seventh Trumpet

Thanks in Heaven...Rev.11:14-19

The death and resurrection of the (2) witnesses is declared to be what? 11:14

This is the end of the second woe, sixth trumpet. This is just about the end...

With the 7th trumpet, what is immediately declared? vs.15 Comment?

The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord... this is it!

Comment on kingdom, not kingdoms. Lu.4:5-7; IICor.4:4; Jn.12:31

The kingdoms of this world are really just one, ruled by Satan. That's now at an end.

And what's the praise of the 24 elders? vs.16-17 See Is.24:17-23

Thanks to the Almighty because you have taken your great power and begun to reign.

Additionally, what else is declared by the elders? vs.18

The time of judgment (nations) and rewards (saints and prophets) has come.

What does John see next? vs.19

He sees the (real) temple of God in heaven opened, and inside was the ark of His covenant.

What happens on earth when this temple is opened and the ark revealed? vs.19

Flashes of lightning, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and a great hailstorm. Attention!

What do we know about the ark from Scripture? Heb.9:3-8

Beneath the mercy seat in Holy of Holies. Held manna, Aaron's rod, tables of covenant.

Why now? What does this scene testify about God? Mt.24:22

God has not forgotten His covenant promises, provisions for His people. Elect is spared...

The Heavenly perspective as the end approaches...Rev.12-15

Before John is shown the chronological events from the 7th trumpet, what does he see? 12:1

He sees a great sign in heaven. This is totally symbolic and almost like a parable.

When does the 7th trumpet chronology return? 15:5

It picks up again with the temple in heaven in chapter 15, verse 5. The end of 1260 days...

Identify the (7) personages detailed in Chapter 12-14. 12:1; 2; 3; 7; 17; 13:1; 13:11

The woman, the Child, the dragon, Michael, her offspring, beast / sea, beast / earth

The first (5) personages all deal with what ongoing battle? Rev.12

It describes the battle between God and Satan with focus on Israel and Christ, Messiah.

What other views do we get in chapters 13-14?

The end of the world political system and the end of the wicked false religions.
