The Philistine Invasion of 1010 BC *(cont'd)*

+ David's problems with Achish

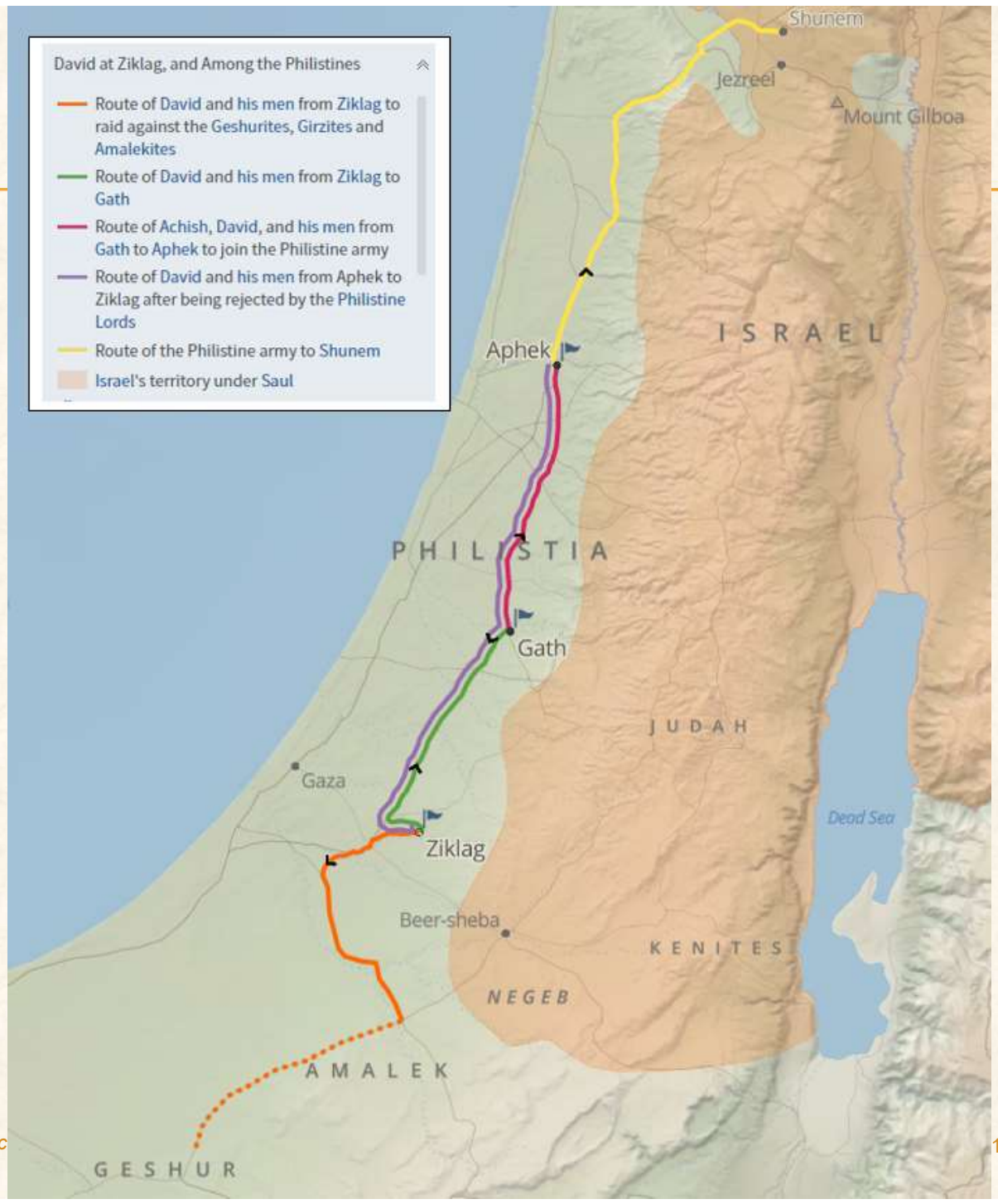
× (29.1-5) The challenge against David

★ Note the battle arrangement at Aphek

× (29.6-11) Achish yields to the commanders' objections

★ Note that Achish pays notice of God in his praises x

- David at Ziklag, and Among the Philistines
- Route of David and his men from Ziklag to raid against the Geshurites, Girzites and Amalekites
 - Route of David and his men from Ziklag to Gath
 - Route of Achish, David, and his men from Gath to Aphek to join the Philistine army
 - Route of David and his men from Aphek to Ziklag after being rejected by the Philistine Lords
 - Route of the Philistine army to Shunem
 - Israel's territory under Saul



1 SAMUEL: CHAPTER 30

The Philistine Invasion of 1010 BC *(cont'd)*

× David's problems on return to Ziklag (30.1-6)

- + Return trip to Ziklag from Aphek was 75 miles, taking three days**
- + On return, David and his men found Ziklag destroyed & burning**
- + David and his men cried out and wept over their losses**
- + Note David's returning to confidence in the Lord x**

1 SAMUEL: CHAPTER 30 *(cont'd)*

The Philistine Invasion of 1010 BC *(cont'd)*

- × **(30.7-10) David takes up the chase**
 - + **He inquired of God if he should pursue the Amalekites or not ... God guarantees their success**
- × **(30.11-15) The Egyptian**
- × **(30.16-17) Vengeance is had**
- × **(30.18-20) The rescue**
- × **(30.21-25) David institutes a new rule**
 - + **Those that stayed with the baggage and protected it were just as valued as those who actually fought**
 - + **God was the One Who gave the victory anyhow, not those who fought**
- × **(30.26-31) David's diplomacy**
 - + **On return to Ziklag, David sent some of the spoils to various parts of Judah x**
